#### Anna's Corner

Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the spirit desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God. You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of right-

eousness. And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

What are your thoughts on the Holy Spirit? Do you see him at work in the world around you and here at Lidgett? Are you aware of him within you, and are you attuned to listening to what the Spirit is telling you? In our busy lives, it is easy to be directed by family and friends, we are constantly bombarded by the media telling us what we should do and think, and it is easy to overlook what the Spirit is drawing us towards (and away from!).

I am regularly amazed by what the Holy Spirit is doing in my life; the people brought into it and the direction it takes. What others might put down to coincidence, I know is down to the Holy Spirit, and I rejoice at what can be done through the power of prayer. Even when things feel uncomfortable, and at odds with what everyone else is doing, I trust that it will all become clear and that everything is part of a grand plan (even the difficult times). I encourage you to take time in the busyness of everyday life to tune in to what the Spirit has to say to you, and share with others what the Holy Spirit is doing in your life, and the lives of those around you.
