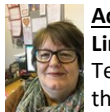

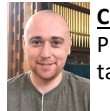

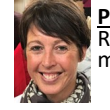

I have heard from many folk that the reason they settled here at Lidgett is because of the quality of the welcome and fellowship here. How fantastic is that! It is certainly the reason I decided to worship here. Last week on the way back from Holy Island I looked around for a service to go to, and went to another Methodist church where I was handed books as I entered, but not spoken to, where the doors to the church space were closed and I wasn't sure where the entrance was. No-one spoke as I entered the pew, despite me having a good look around and being willing to smile at folk, nor as I left the church. I came away thinking that perhaps they get loads of holidaymakers and trying to understand things from their perspective, but I also came away feeling very encouraged that here we do smile at people, and engage them in conversation, and make them feel that they matter—to us and to God.

Also, it has been a bit of a week with various electrical difficulties—yet our faithful café staff volunteers dealt with kitchenette issues with good humour and patience, and those brought in to resolve that and other difficulties came promptly and happily. I'm sure we all want to say a heartfelt *Thank You* to all who give their time and energy so willingly (and sometimes sacrificially) across so many aspects of our fellowship, outreach and maintenance, and go that extra mile to make Lidgett what it is. *Lín*
