Orders can be placed through the stall which helps the church, means you don't pay delivery charges and you don't pay until the goods arrive (usually a couple of weeks).

Please do pray for the folk at Traidcraft as they may have to cease trading at the end of 2018 unless a solution can be found in the coming months to end the recent poor trading figures after the pound fell after the Brexit decision and Traidcraft took the decision to honour the prices already published for the goods sold.
