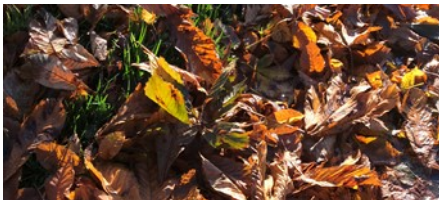

It will be a busy Sunday next week, as we welcome our friends from Poppleton to share in the café style service, with an Act of Remembrance and celebration of Holy Communion.

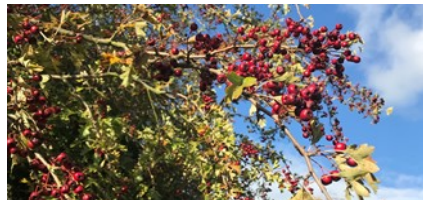
