**Sundays!** On Sunday afternoons, not long after the end of our services, our church space is let out to (often) music groups to rehearse—which of course brings in valuable and much-needed income. But for the space to be suitable it needs to be clear of all Sunday morning furniture and any other items. **So... before leaving the services on Sundays, please could we possibly ask that you...**

- 1) take home your service sheet
- 2) take any bible or service book back to the shelves
- 3) stack your chair on top of a nearby chair/chairs (4 chairs in each stack maximum)
- 4) return all crockery to the serving counter to be washed
- 5) (And for Café Services) put all the pens etc back in the containers on the table, take home anything you have lovingly made, and put any rubbish in the bin near the serving counter. Give the table a quick wipe, fold up the tablecloth, and fold up the table and replace onto the rack.

**We don't have Ray's caretaking services on a weekend, so if each of us does some or all of the above, it makes clearing up so much easier and less onerous for those who finish up having to put all the chairs away, sweep floors etc.**
