An update from Heather...

From 1st May, I will be working for the Circuit for 10 hours a week as a Children and Families worker, job sharing the role with Lorraine Jones from Haxby. Our role is to support those involved in children's and family ministry across the circuit and to encourage churches to explore ways of engaging with families in their communities. We'll be providing support to help set up activities such as Messy Churches, community cafes, toddler groups, Dad's breakfast groups, parenting groups, holiday clubs and develop links with schools. We will work as part of a team with Amy Shepherd, the circuit youth worker and Victoria Etherington, the District Youth worker and will also be involved in delivering circuit wide children and youth programmes, such as the One X Programme.

Personal & Spiritual **Development Course**
